Reading Hall of Fame for December

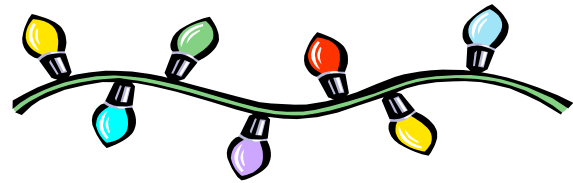
