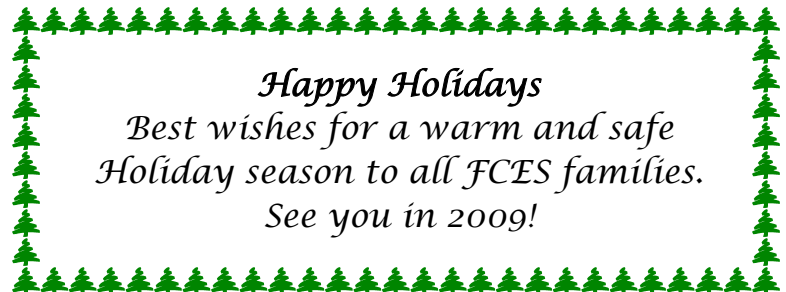
### PARENT TO DO LIST
