Did you get your School Bond Ballot?

Did you know that Fall City Elementary School will receive a long list of repairs and upgrades in the bond proposition now currently on the ballot? From a new playground surface, to a video security system, to new paint and flooring - the bond provides upgrades and repairs to keep our schools safe and well-maintained. Our **student's future schools, Chief Kanim and Mount Si**, receive a long list of repairs and upgrades too.

The bond also provides classroom space at Mount Si High School. There are over 100 more freshmen coming in September than there are seniors leaving in June. The bond provides for 12 modular classrooms with covered walkways to open in September.

The bond will represent a lower cost to taxpayers. Due to a larger bond that expired last year, this bond proposition represents a net decrease in our tax rate.

Election ballots are due by March 10th. Mail them in or use the drop box at Fall City Public Library. *Remember that every vote counts!*
