All you need to do is order before June 26th. There are two ways to order:

By June 26th, order online from the comfort of your home: Go to www.epipacks.com, enter FAL000 then click **GO**, and pay with your credit card. You will receive direct confirmation from Educational Products, so you do not need to return this order form to the school.

By June 24th, complete an order form and return it to the school with a check: Make your check payable to *FCES PTSA*. We cannot accept check orders past June 24th (last day of school). Order forms can be picked up in the school lobby.
